"do this in remembrance of me"

A RITE is an established ceremonial or religious act.

A SACRAMENT is a <u>Christian rite</u> recognized as of particular importance and significance.

### EUCHARIST (eucharistia) means "to give thanks"

"and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." 1 Corinthians 11:24

Romans 6:9-10 "For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. <sup>10</sup> The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God."

# These ordinances are the signs of grace, not the means of grace

## "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent" John 6:29

#### "Do this in remembrance of me"

"While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body." 27 Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. 28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. <sup>29</sup> I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom." 30 When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives." Matt 26:26-30

### Communion:

Sharing one's intimate thoughts or feelings, especially on a spiritual level

"Jesus replied, "The one who has dipped his hand into the bowl with me will betray me. <sup>24</sup> The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born." Matt 26: 23-24

Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment on himself." 1 Cor 11: 27-29

"For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes" 1 Corinthians 11:26
