

# Crying for DELYVERAFICE

Psalm 120

So much of what we go through in our hardships and struggles cause us to look up at this whole relationship and journey with God.

Our relationship with God can seem distant and disconnected sometimes because of how we feel and what we are going through.

How do we interact with this one that is so far beyond us, and who is so far above us, and feel that sense of closeness and nearness that He promises to us?

When we are going through certain things in our lives... That is often the most defining time we look up to Him.

Our relationship with God is vertical..., When we see it this way, then we will see His work and interaction played out in our lives.

We must be going upward in our journey with God. . .

- 1.Distress from Oppression (v. 1)
- 2.Deliverance from Deceit (v. 2-4)
- 3.Desire for Peace (v. 5-7)

1 I call on the LORD in my distress, and he answers me.

We don't have to look far to find those who are looking to create some type of drama or division through attacks.

Jn. 16:33

". . .In the world you will have tribulation:. . ."

#### Distress:

It's the idea that there are those in our lives who are being difficult on us, trying to ruin things for us, or. . .

...putting us in those tight spots where it is difficult to turn the other way and absorb that attack.

There are some things for us to realize that can help us:

- 1. You are not alone (v. 1)
- 2. Our God will defend (v. 2)
- 3. God is at work in your life and theirs.

There are also some principles that we need to establish:

- 1. Don't be that person
- 2. Don't retaliate
- 3. Be a blessing

#### Question:

Do you have an upward focus in your relationship with God that moves you from the distress of your situations to dependence in Him?

2 Save me, LORD, from lying lips and from deceitful tongues. 3What will he do to you, and what more besides, you deceitful tongue? 4 He will punish you with a warrior's sharp arrows, with burning coals of the broom bush

2. Deliverance from Deceit Prov. 6:16 "There are six things the LORD hates, seven that are detestable to him:... 19 a false witness who pours out lies and a person who stirs up conflict in the community."

Have you ever had a rumor spread about you that wasn't even remotely true? And you knew that the only reason for it was to ruin you as a person and your reputation.

How did it make you feel at the time?

Anger Depression Frustration

All you want in the heat of that moment is deliverance. . .

Sometimes we can be directed more by the deceit in those moments than be directed to God.

When our names are being drug through the mud, our greatest asset is our reputation... It's Not! It is our dependency on God.

#### Question:

Are you being directed upward to God and directed by Him in the midst of deceit? Or are you being directed by something else?

5 Woe to me that I dwell in Meshek, that I live among the tents of Kedar! 6 Too long have I lived among those who hate peace. 7 I am for peace; but when I speak, they are for war.

All of us would agree that one thing we want over the course and scope of our lives is this constancy of peace.

As much as we want peace in our lives and in our world, there are possibly less of us that would say we are intentional about creating peace.

What the change in a room with other individuals might be when you enter.

What steps are we taking to promote peace in our own lives and others?

When we are not intentional about showing peace in our lives, it will always open the door to chaos.

#### Question:

If we are truly all about desiring peace, then what proactive steps are we taking that genuinely and intentionaly make that happen?
