Our Help Begins with Perspective

In the midst of our crisis or struggle, we tend to focus more on the circumstance, rather than look to God for help.

Our Help Begins with Perspective

If we know God is our help, then we must make the conscious decision in each of the moments we are in to direct our attention to Him.

Our Help Begins with Perspective The first step we take in difficult situations, each and every time:

... Lift our eyes and look to God
