Partnered with Cindy Ray and the Children's Ministry by donating:

- o \$200.00 for the Easter Outreach.
- \$200.00 for the Carnival Outreach.
- o \$100.00 for the Corn Maze Outreach
- o \$200.00 for the Christmas Outreach.
- Donated \$800.00 worth of gift cards to local fire victims.
